ORGANIZING COMMITTEE:

The Junior World Championship and the Master World Cup are organized by the Ecuadorian Federation FEFICULP, the South American Confederation CSFF and the International Federation of Bodybuilding and Fitness IFBB.

EVENT CITY:

Quito, capital of Ecuador, surrounded by large volcanoes, formed by streets and colonial houses, is a city where people try to preserve their colorful traditions. RECEPTION OF DELEGATIONS:

The delegations can plan their flights to the Mariscal Sucre International Airport in the city of Quito. The Organizing Committee will have delegates at the airport coordinating the arrival of each delegation.

The reception of the delegations will be hosted by the FEFICULP on the days established as official: arrival November 30 and departure December 3. Those who travel on other dates must make their own travel arrangements.

CONFIRMATION OF ARRIVAL AND FLIGHT:

INTERNAL TRANSPORTATION:

The transport airport - hotel - airport will cost 20 dollars for each member of the delegation.

ACCOMMODATION:

The Organizing Committee will provide accommodation for 3 nights and 3 meals a day, to the athletes and delegates duly registered, from the official arrival day Friday, November 30th to Monday, December 3rd, day of departure of the delegations.

In accordance to the regulations of the IFBB:

- ✓ Three or more competitors: Two delegates
- ✓ Less than three competitors: One delegate

FEFICULP will not be responsible for the payment of costs caused by additional days of lodging, consumption and / or extra delegates. These will be under total responsibility of each National Federation.

If a National Federation sends its registration and does not attend, that Federation must pay to the Ecuadorian Federation the expenses incurred for that group.

Any judge, coach or delegate who is not an official participant will be responsible for all their expenses.

SPECIAL PACKAGES FOR EXTRA DELEGATES:

The Organizing Committee has established a special complete package, which includes three (3) nights of accommodation, with three (3) meals per day (breakfast, lunch and dinner), tickets for competitions and internal transportation, at a cost of \$ 400 per person in a double room or \$550 per person in a single room.

EARLY ARRIVALS / LATE DEPARTURES:

The National Delegation or one of the team members, who arrives before the official arrival date of **November 30th** and / or stays after the official departure date of **December 3rd**, will be responsible for all their expenses, including the arrengement of transportation from the airport to the hotel or vice versa.

The Organizing Committee can facilitate transportation before and after the official arrival and departure dates at a cost of 30 dollars per person per trip. The accommodation at the official hotel before the official arrival date and after the official departure date will cost approximately 70 dollars per person per night in a double room, breakfast included. It is necessary to notify until November 19th about early arrivals and / or late departures.

HOTEL SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The Head of the Delegation must deposit **100 dollars for each member of the delegation**, at the time of check-in at the hotel, this value will be used as warranty against possible damages caused during the stay in sheets, towels, carpets and / or furniture.

This deposit will be refunded once <u>all the rooms</u> of the Delegation are checked out.

MEALS:

The Organizing Committee will provide meals from lunch on Friday, November 30th to breakfast on Monday, December 3rd.

REGISTRATION FEE:

Each athlete and official delegate must pay to the IFBB registration fee of **300 dollars** per participant, which must be paid in advance by credit / debit card or PayPal on the IFBB website: http://www.ifbb.com/competition-registration. Please add your name during the online payment and bring a copy of your payment confirmation to the register.

The deadline to make the payment online is Monday, November 19th until 24:00 (European time). If you pay in the register on November 30th, you will be charged an additional 50 dollar fee per participant.

The hotel security deposit and the IFBB registration fee must be paid before the team members can stay.

INTERNATIONAL IFBB CARD:

Athletes must present their International IFBB Card to compete, it costs 40 dollars or 30 Euros for those who do not have it or must renew their annual membership.

WEIGHING AND REGISTRATION OF ATHLETES:

The weighing and registration of the athletes will take place on Friday, **November 30**th, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Tambo Real Hotel, Av. 12 de Octubre y Patria.

Athletes will have to present their passport or identity document and the international IFBB card for registration.

Each athlete will receive a bracelet from the competition during the registration, this allows entry to the place of competition and other activities of the Championship, should not be removed.

COMPETITION MUSIC:

During the weighing, each athlete must deliver a properly identified USB drive, which must contain only the competition music in MP3 format, with the time established in the regulations of each modality. The use of profane, vulgar and offensive language is strictly prohibited in the music of posing.

PARTICIPATION:

This Championship and World Cup are open to all the National Federations affiliated to the IFBB from all over the world. The participation of athletes is unlimited, registration can only be done through their National Federations.

It is important to take into account that it is the total responsibility and obligation of the National Federations to verify that each of the athletes who register for this international event are not suspended, or fulfilling a period of ineligibility due to an anti-doping rule violation or any another disciplinary case at national or international level.

Important note: five is the minimum number of competitors to open a category. If there are less than 5 athletes, the categories can be combined, whenever possible.

PRELIMINARY REGISTRATION FORM:

The deadline to submit the preliminary registration form is **October 31**st. The National Federations must confirm the intention to participate by indicating the total number of athletes and delegates that will make up the Delegation.

FINAL REGISTRATION FORM:

The deadline to submit the final registration form is Monday, November 19th. The National Federations must send the names of all the participants (athletes by category and delegates, including judges). They must also include flight arrival and departure information. This information is essential to guarantee accommodation in the hotel and adequate transportation for the team.

If a National Federation does not respect the deadline for sending the final registration form, each "official participant" of that federation must pay 400 dollars (double room) or 550 dollars (single room) instead of the registration IFBB fee.

DOPING CONTROLS:

The Doping Commission of the IFBB, in coordination with the National Doping Commission of Ecuador, will be responsible for carrying out the controls, using a laboratory accredited by WADA.

To compete in the World Championship, all athletes must sign a doping test consent and exemption form during the registration.

Doping tests can be done using any of the following methods:

- Random selection: a number of athletes selected at random during the event
- Weighted selection: a number of athletes selected at random from the best finalists
- The IFBB reserves the right to prove any athlete

The IFBB is a signatory to the WADA Code. The participating National Federations have the duty and the obligation to guarantee that the athletes of their national team compete without doping problems in the international events of the IFBB.

JUDGES:

To be considered within the panels of judges of the World Championship, the International Judges as well as the Test Judges must be included in the final registration form sent by each National Federation.

The Judges must bring their international card with the updated payment of 2018 of EUR €50 or USD \$60. The test judges must pay EUR €50 or USD \$60 to carry out their evaluation.

All the judges must be present at the technical meeting on Friday, November 30th, those who do not attend will not be able to judge in the World Championship.

GREEN CARDS:

The green cards, used to limit access to the backstage area during the competition, will be delivered at the technical meeting on Friday, November 30th, as follows:

- Five (5) or more competitors two (2) green cards
- Less than five (5) competitors one (1) green card

If the officers of the National Federation do not attend the meeting, this federation will not have a green card.

COACHES - BACKSTAGE:

Only accredited coaches can enter the backstage to assist participating athletes. For this, the IFBB will hand out bracelets and accreditations to the Head of Delegation of each country.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND FILMING:

The IFBB will accredit the press and photography staff that can enter the event, who will have a special area in front of the competition stage and in the dressing rooms. Access to people without authorization will NOT be allowed.

The World Championship will be broadcasted live, through the official web sites: www.csff-ifbb.com. The IFBB has exclusive rights to the event.

Cameras and video recording equipment are strictly prohibited in backstage and dressing rooms, except when used by authorized IFBB personnel and media.

TRAVEL MEDICAL INSURANCE:

It is mandatory that all members of the Delegation have travel medical insurance, covering mainly medical and / or hospital care that may be required during the trip and / or competition. The FEFICULP and the IFBB are not responsible for medical expenses.

MISREPRESENTATION:

Misrepresentation is a serious violation of the IFBB Code of Ethics and occurs when an "official" of a National Federation deliberately misrepresents the number of athletes and delegates to obtain free accommodation, meals, internal transportation, access to competitions, farewell dinner and other services by the organizer.

Part of this misrepresentation may be a false claim that a person is an athlete only to have the benefits of being one but, is not officially registered as a competitor at the weigh-in, or once they have registered they do not show up to compete.

The National Federation declared guilty of misrepresentation will be immediately disqualified from the World Championship and a fine equivalent to the special package fee will be imposed for each person involved.

MEDICAL WITHDRAWAL:

Once it has been officially registered, no Athlete may withdraw from the competition without the prior approval of the Chief Judge of the IFBB. It is not acceptable for a National Federation to unilaterally withdraw an athlete without the prior approval of the IFBB. The Chief Judge has the right to verify the reason for the withdrawal.

The National Federation that does not request the prior approval of the IFBB Main Judge before withdrawing an athlete, will be fined with an amount equal to the special package rate.

FAILURE OF COOPERATION:

The lack of cooperation with the Organizing Committee is contrary to the IFBB Code of Ethics and may result in disciplinary sanctions.

VISAS:

A valid passport is required to enter Ecuador, most countries do not require a visa, however it is important that you verify the information of your country: https://www.cancilleria.gob.ec/

An official letter of invitation will be available if necessary. It is the responsibility of the National Federations to obtain the entry visa if this is the case.

CERTIFICATES:

The FEFICULP will deliver official certificates to all participants in the World Championship, duly signed by the authorities.

FLAGS AND NATIONAL ANTHEMS:

The participating countries must bring the music of their respective national anthems (abbreviated version) on a compact disc (CD). Similarly, national flags with a measure of 2.5 x 1.5 meters.

PARADE OF NATIONS:

The mandatory dress code for all delegates participating in the Parade of Nations will be the official uniform of the IFBB.

CLIMATE:

For the month of December, the average temperature in Quito is 10 to 20 degrees Celsius.

TIME DIFFERENCE:

GMT - 5 hours

CURRENCY:

The official currency of Ecuador is the American Dollar.

ELECTRICAL CURRENT:

Voltage: 120 V Frequency: 60 Hz Plugs: Type A / B

LANGUAGE:

The official language of Ecuador is Spanish, but English is widely spoken.
